Terms and Conditions

The Holy Trinity Gascoigne Educational Scholarship Fund is administered by the Finance Committee of Holy Trinity Parish which may delegate to a sub-committee to make recommendations on the award of the scholarship. Enquiries and applications should be sent to *The Chairman, Finance Committee PO Box 15-256 Miramar, Wellington 6243.*

1. The Scholarship is open to all age groups. Applicants must be present members of Holy Trinity Parish, Wellington.
2. Applicants should be able to show active participation in the activities of Holy Trinity Parish.
3. Applications must be received by the Finance Committee of Holy Trinity by the **31st October** of each year and are to be submitted on the application form. Scholarships may be awarded subject to examinations marks and course enrolment.
4. Applicants must be planning to study for any recognised qualification at a tertiary level at a New Zealand education or training institution (i.e. polytechnic, university or for an apprenticeship).
5. Applications must be supported by:
 - 5.1 at least one written reference (from a school principal, dean, past or present employer or other appropriate referee)
 - 5.2 contact details for another referee whom the scholarship committee may contact
 - 5.3 a 250 word essay on *“Why I have chosen the course of study I have, my intended career and what I would like to achieve with the qualification and in my career”*
6. The purpose of the scholarship is to assist those whose financial circumstances might otherwise prevent them from pursuing their chosen field of study. Applicants are to make supporting comments where they believe this to be appropriate.

7. Each scholarship will be an amount of up to \$3,000 per annum for a period of up to two years. Scholarship payments will generally be restricted to course fees. Scholarship payments for year two are subject to the following conditions:
 - 7.1 Applicants must re-apply for the scholarship in their second year
 - 7.2 They must include with their application a brief review of their previous year's performance and an outline of their proposed course of study for the year ahead
 - 7.3 Satisfactory performance in the preceding year as shown by the previous year's examination results
 - 7.4 The Finance Committee's approval for continuation of the Scholarship approval will be entirely at the Finance Committee's discretion.

8. Applicants will be required to attend an interview as part of their application. Decisions made by the Finance Committee in relation to any scholarship will be final. In accepting the scholarship, the recipient consents to publicity concerning the award in Parish newsletters and similar publications.
